We wanted to review with you some of the guidelines for the virtual interview process to ensure a welcoming environment and seamless process for everyone involved in the interviews.

- Please make sure to test your audio and video connection prior to your scheduled interview day. We are utilizing the Zoom platform for the virtual interviews. If you are unsure of the technical set-up, please e-mail our program managers and we can run a connectivity test with you in advance.
- Please make sure to use your audio and video connection through a laptop or desktop PC. If
 you would like to join the session using your tablet or smartphone, make sure to inform our
 program coordinators in advance to account for the differences in how we have to move you
 around the breakout rooms.
- During the interview, please make sure to have your camera on through the in-person virtual sessions.
- Please try to complete the interview in private, with minimal surrounding distractions.
- Please do not forward the links or the resources provided to you for the interview day with any other individuals.
- Please do not share the questions that you are asked during the interview with other applicants.
- If you are unable to make it to the scheduled session or if you are having technical difficulties joining any part of the scheduled sessions, please reach out to our program managers.
- We will be providing universal background slides for the virtual interviews. However, these are completely optional so feel free to use them or not.
