# For success in Phase 3 and applying to Radiology, we recommend:

- Meet with Mark Kleedehn, IR Residency Program Director.
- Focus elective rotations in surgery and critical care
- Join and participate in the SIR RFS
- IR specific research is essentially required.
- 1-2 away rotations at your targeted programs are recommended.
- You must apply to another specialty besides IR. Almost all candidates dual apply to DR, as this gives them the opportunity to pursue ESIR
