If you are interested in both DR and IR-Integrated, rank both accordingly. If you are interested in only one or the other, then only rank that program with the correct code. You do have the ability to update the tracks that you are applying to via ERAS, but that is not the same as updating your Rank List. Also, note that it is not essential to have applied to all the programs via ERAS. It is, however, essential that you RANK the programs that you are interested in matching into.

Similarly, if you are applying to DR you may choose to rank either, both, or neither of the preliminary tracks. There is not a separate application or interview process for the preliminary internal medicine or preliminary general surgery programs. Rank either, both, or neither of the preliminary tracks as you see fit and ensure that you are using the appropriate NRMP codes. Because our preliminary positions are attached to our advanced positions, the preliminary programs would be entered and ranked on your supplemental rank order list.

If you are interested in the IR-Integrated program, we would prefer that you do a preliminary year in surgery, and it would be most beneficial to do that preliminary year here, at UW, as you will be working closely with the UW surgeons throughout your training. There is one surgery preliminary year attached to the IR-Integrated residency; you must use this NRMP code to be eligible to match into this position with the IR-Integrated residency.
